Dear Club/Team Manager,

The Berks, Bucks and Oxon Cross Country Association (*BBO*) Championships for 2023 are scheduled to be held on **Sunday, 19th November 2023 at Newbury Showground** and will be hosted by Newbury AC. Full details of the schedule for the day of the Championships will be sent out to all clubs by early November 2023 in a Final Details Newsletter and will also be made available on the website.

Invitation

Clubs and organisations are invited to submit their entries for the 2023 BBO Championships. The closing date for membership and payment of the membership fee is **Sunday**, 5th **November 2023**. *Note: Non-receipt of affiliation and/or entry fees by the closing date will result in exclusion from the 2023 BBO Championships*.

Volunteers Request

Volunteers will be required in order to enable the 2023 BBO Championships to go ahead. Marshals as well as a Fixture Referee, Adjudicator, Timekeepers, Recorders and a Results Runners will all be required. The Volunteers Request Form included later within this document is requested to be completed and returned by any clubs able to supply volunteers for the 2023 BBO Championships (*– see page 4 of this document*).

Lyme Disease Notice

When running through woodlands there is always a risk of being bitten by ticks etc. and therefore insect repellent containing DEET is advisable. Unfortunately, if a tick is infected with Lyme disease there is a possibility of it passing on the disease to runners. If after having run through woodlands or long grass you notice a red circular rash around a bite mark, it would be advisable to get it checked out sooner rather than later. Age Categories

Please ensure all athletes are correctly entered. All athlete entries will be verified against the athlete's date of birth as registered with England Athletics.

- Under 13 Boys & Girls: 11 or 12 years of age on 31st August 2023. (Athletes under the age of 11 must not be entered – as per updated UKA 2022-24 rule T3 S3(1).)
- Under 15 Boys & Girls: 13 or 14 years of age on 31st August 2023.
- Under 17 Boys & Girls: 15 or 16 years of age on 31st August 2023.
- Under 20 Men & Women: 17, 18 or 19 years of age on 31st August 2023.
- Senior Men & Women: 20-34 years of age on 31st August 2023.
- Veteran Men & Women: 35 years of age on 31st August 2023.

Championship Prizes

- Under 13 Boys & Girls / Under 15 Boys & Girls / Under 17 Boys & Girls:
 - Medals to be awarded to the first three athletes in each category to finish.
 - Medals also to be awarded to the first three athletes of the first three teams in each category, subject to a minimum of eight teams being entered.
 - Category trophy to be awarded to the winning team.

• Under 20 Men & Women / Senior Men & Women / Veteran Men & Women:

- Medals to be awarded to the first three Under 20, Senior and Veteran athletes to finish.
- Medals also to be awarded to the first three athletes (first six athletes in the case of the men) of the first three teams, subject to a minimum of eight teams being entered.
- Overall team trophy to be awarded to the winning men's and women's teams.
- Veteran team trophy to be awarded to the winning veteran men's and women's teams.

Rules

All clubs, organisations and athletes are advised and reminded to read the BBO Rules (*– please refer to the BBO Rules as set out on the BBO website: https://bbocca.uk/about/rules/*).

Entry Form & Payment of Fees

Please complete the separate entry form (*– see page 5 of this document*) and return the form along with the remittance for the entry fees due either by post or by email as specified on the form.

Athlete & Team Entries

Athlete and team entries are at the same time to be submitted to the Entries & Results Secretary using the separate .csv (*– can be opened by any spreadsheet program*) supplied, again by the deadline indicated at the bottom of the entry form.

Race Numbers

Race numbers are to be collected on the day. All athletes are advised to arrive early to ensure they collect their race numbers ahead of their race with sufficient time to spare.

Entry Guidance Notes

- 1) Each competitor must be:
 - a. a first claim members of the club they represent.
 - b. registered with England Athletics (EA) and their EA registration fee have been paid and processed.
 - c. eligible to compete under UK Athletics (UKA) Rules for cross country running.
- 2) Individual entries may be entered by an affiliated club.
- 3) All entries must be submitted using the .csv entries template provided. Please ensure the .csv file format is retained on submission of entries and double-check the athlete dates of birth to ensure the correct data is submitted.
- 4) Athlete eligibility to compete will be checked using the athlete EA registration number (URN). The status of an athlete's EA registration can be checked by visiting: https://myathletics.englandathletics.org/licencecheck/.
- 5) Any athlete whose entry fails the EA Licence Check will be refused entry to the 2023 BBO Cross Country Championships, unless the issue associated with his/her entry is resolved by the secondary entry deadline of Monday, 13th November.
- 6) Club vests must be worn in all races.
- 7) The Under 17 Boys and Girls run together.
